Chevrolet introduced the 327 engine on the 1962 Corvette by enlarging the cylinders of the 283-cubic inch, small-block V-8. The highest power output came from a fuel-injected model, and the rest each had a single four-barrel carburetor. The compression ratios ranged from 10.5:1 and 11.5:1.
