Spykman reasoned that a prerequisite for the US to be able to maintain its supremacy in the world, just like the British Empire did before it, is developing a strong navy and maintaining a strong presence in what he called the 'rimland' (or Mackinder's inner crescent) either through military outposts or pro-US allied governments.

The concept of geopolitics (or geopolitik, as Germans called it) was proposed by Swedish political scientist Rudolf Kjellen in 1905. Its focus was political geography and combined Mackinder's heartland theory with Friedrich Ratzel's theory on the organic nature of the state.

Spykman owed much of his thought to Mahan's stress of geographical position, especially on Mackinder's Outer Crescent which Spykman renamed "Rimlands." The Rimlands, according to Spykman, function as a vast buffer zone of conflict between sea power and land power. It then must defend itself from both.
