In 780,JabiribnHayyan, a Muslim chemist who is considered by many to be the father of chemistry, introduced the experimental scientific method for chemistry, as well as laboratory apparatus such as the alembic, still and retort, and chemical processes such as pure distillation, liquefaction,crystallisation, and filtration.
He also invented more than twenty types of laboratory apparatus, leading to the discovery of many chemical substances.
