A building added later in Copán’s history is known as the “Popol Nah” or Community House and was the place where these lords met. Inscriptions on the building tell us that a “Council of Nine” met there, and between them they controlled Copan’s periphery settlements, which at their zenith had a population of 20,000.

Copan was devastated by fire in 1906, 1911, and 1912. Its population increased from 305 in 1907 to 521 in 1930, 549 in 1940, and 675 in 1970, reaching a high of 960 in 1980. The town had 796 residents in 2000 and 733 in 2010. Because of nearby Hulah and Copan lakes, Copan's present economy is based upon tourism and recreation.
