Both bricks and concrete masonry are relatively inexpensive. As of 2011, a single clay brick costs about \$1.50, while an 8 inch concrete block costs about \$1.35. Special lightweight blocks can cost as much as \$3.00 each. Labor can bring wall prices up significantly, however.

## **Concrete Block Vs. Brick | Hunker**

Estimate 7-9 bags of masonry cement per 1000 bricks of any size. Estimate 3 bags of masonry cement per 100 (8" x 8" x 16") concrete block. Masonry cement adds almost no volume to a prepared mortar, it simply coats the sand particles. [.33 cubic feet (CF) of cementitious materials and .99 CF of sand will make 1 CF of mortar] 1 part masonry cement
