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needs to meet with employees from each shift. In order for the committee to do its job, employees must report near misses as soon as they occur. Otherwise details will be lost.

Remember a near miss is an event that could have caused harm. If you don't investigate a near miss, you are missing an opportunity to prevent an accident. If the near miss repeats, next time, someone could be injured. And, when an accident occurs, it does become a legal

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requirement to record it, and if its serious enough, to report it to the HSE.
